Hello Cradock Baptist Family:

It is good to talk with you again and at least I have updated information on our steeple. The structural engineer has finally given his preliminary designs to the architect. The next step is for the architect to give his drawings and suggestions back to the structural engineer, and then the preliminary construction can begin, as I understand it. I do not have a beginning date yet, but I hope it is soon as this has been drawn out way too long. Yes, this has been a long drawn out process, but to date the insurance company has paid everything and we have had no out of pocket expense. We hope that continues, but we will see.






